Treasurer's report: Jerry Klein presented the Treasurer's Report, stating there was \$41,598.87 in the checking account and \$12,808.39 in the dam reserve account.

The board approved a motion to pay invoices due totaling \$4,544.83. Motion made by Linda Hamilton and seconded by Kate Conlow.

Property Committee: Kate Conlow reported on two applications from property owners. Regarding both applications, additional information is being requested by the committee.
